Ways to Read Together

Read the Pictures	Talk in detail about every picture in the book.
Read the Words	Use your strategies to decode words you do not know.
Retell a Book You Just Read	Go through the book page by page, retelling the book with a lot of details, using the pictures and the words.
Check for Understanding	Think about what the author is telling you when you read. Stop often to be sure you understand your reading ("I just read that").
I Read, You Read	The more fluent partner reads a page, while the second partner follows along. Then, the second partner reads the same page, to build fluency and expression.
Choral Reading	Both partners read the same page together, at the same time, to build fluency and expression.
